ZooCamp Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Will my children get to play with the animals?

A. Children will meet some of our education animal ambassadors. They may get to **touch** a mammal or a reptile, but they will not play with the animals.

Q. Will my children get to go behind-the-scenes for ZooCamp?

A. The only programs that include behind-the-scenes portions are Working at the Zoo (10, 11 & 12 yr. olds); Zoo Vet (13 & 14 yr. olds); and Jr. Keeper (15 & 16 yr. olds)

Q. How should I dress my child for ZooCamp?

A. The programs are held rain or shine so dress your child according to the weather. They must wear comfortable play clothes and shoes; NO FLIP FLOPS!

Q. Can I stay at ZooCamp with my child?

A. No, only parents that have informed us of their child's special requirements will be permitted to stay with their child.

- * Please complete a separate registration sheet for each child. Photocopies are acceptable.
- * Please include a check payable to the Akron Zoo or credit card information with each registration form.
- * To pay with cash, please register in person at the Akron Zoo.
- * Mail completed registration form and check to Akron Zoo, 500 Edgewood Avenue, Akron, OH 44307.
- * To insure that siblings and friends are enrolled in the same sessions, mail the registration forms in the same envelope.
- * Please include a note if your child requires any special accommodations during ZooCamp.
- * WE WILL NOT ACCEPT PHONE REGISTRATIONS.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

- * Individuals who wish to cancel a registration must notify the Education Department IN WRITING no less than two weeks prior to the first date of the session. We will refund 50% of the session fee upon receipt of a written cancellation.
- * There will be no refunds for cancellations made less that two weeks prior to the first date of the session.
- * The Education Department reserves the right to cancel any session with insufficient registration.
- * There is a **\$10 service charge** for any changes in the original registration.
- * Pre-registration is required for all sessions.
