- Camp Care: \$40 per child per week.  
*Includes Before Care (8:00-9:30am) and After Care (4:30-5:30pm). A late fee of \$1 per child per minute will be charged starting at 5:40pm.*
- Meal Deal: \$25 per child per week.  
*Meal deals include a daily set box lunch (accommodations can be made or allergies).*
- Any of the options above can be purchased the week of camp for an additional \$5 fee.

### Cancellation & Refund Policy

- If the cancellation occurs **two or more weeks** before the first day of the camp, a 50% refund will be issued onto an Akron Zoo gift card.
