## FROM THE CHAIR & PRESIDENT

Your Akron Zoo has had a busy year and we couldn't be more proud of what we have accomplished. We celebrated the birth of a Humboldt penguin chick in March, who came to the zoo as an egg from the Columbus Zoo and Aquarium. It was deemed a high priority in terms of genetic diversity and the decision was made by the Humboldt Penguin Species Survival Plan (SSP) to send the egg to the Akron Zoo. This collaboration is a wonderful example of AZA institutions working together for the benefit of an endangered species.

We also celebrated a huge achievement toward our mission of connecting all lives to wildlife while inspiring lifelong learning and conservation action. The Akron Zoo was recently honored by the Association of Zoos and Aquariums (AZA) with the Angela Peterson Excellence in Diversity Award for our age-friendly initiative. This award is a significant achievement and testament to the dedication of our staff and community.

While we reflect on our achievements of the past year, we also look toward the exciting future that we have in store. In 2025, your Akron Zoo will welcome 20 animatronic dinosaurs to our park! This exhibit provides guests an opportunity to learn about the incredible adaptations dinosaurs used to survive, reinforcing the importance of saving animals from extinction with present-day efforts.

We broke ground on a new state-of-the-art animal hospital. The Akron Zoo provides in-house care for animal residents on a daily basis, including regular check-ups, management of diseases and chronic conditions, surgeries and end-of-life care. The 11,949 square-foot building will include a surgery suite, intensive care unit and specialized spaces for the different species, including birds, hoofstock, primates and large carnivores.

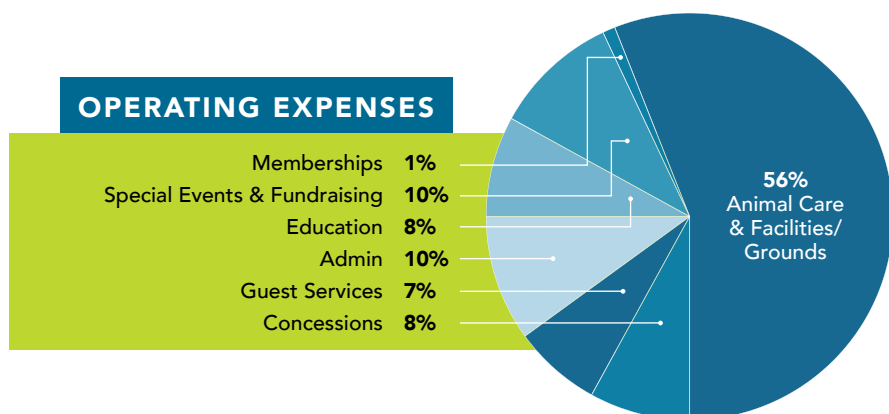
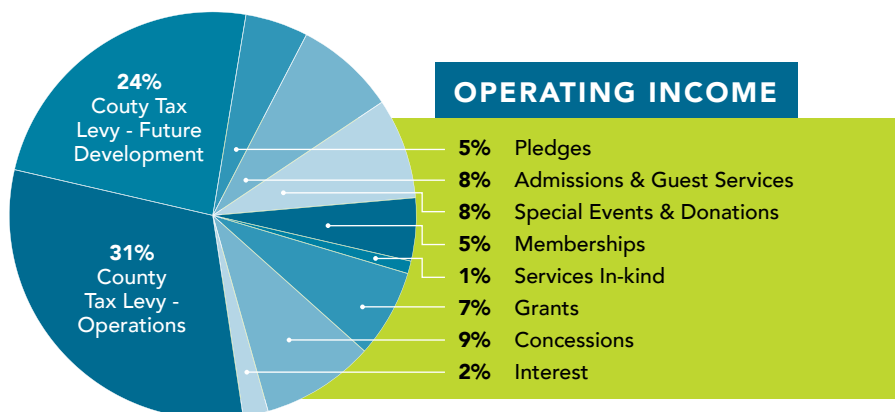
