# CANS FOR CORRIDORS

Please bring us your empty aluminum cans! Cans for Corridors is a global effort started by the Durrell Wildlife Conservation Trust in 2002.

Tree corridors are used by many different animals, such as tamarins, jaguars, capybaras, birds and more, to move from area to area. Proceeds from recycling are used to purchase native trees to replant and connect patches of the rainforest in Brazil. One tree only cost 75 cents, which is the equivalent of 45-50 aluminum cans. Drop off your aluminum cans in the recycling chute in the center of lot C parking anytime throughout the year, and zoo staff will do the rest! With your help, we can help plant trees and ensure the continued survival of several endangered species that call the rainforest home.
